Well Done Rufus & Spencer!



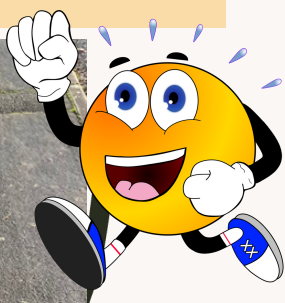

Well done, Seb!



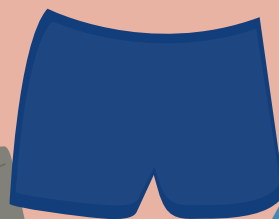
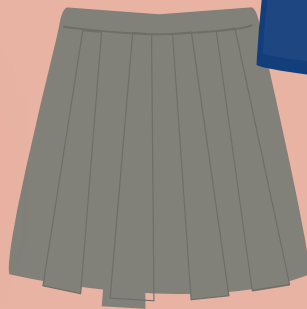
