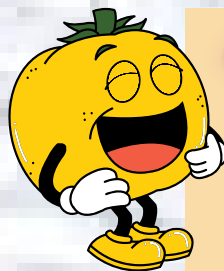

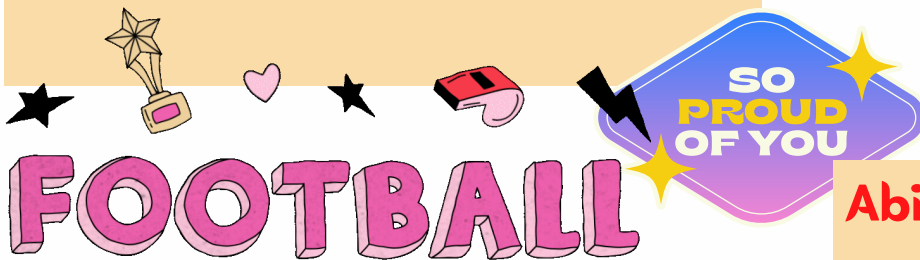
Champion Moments

This week we have Dottie. Dottie has appeared on stage for her performance, displaying so much confidence!

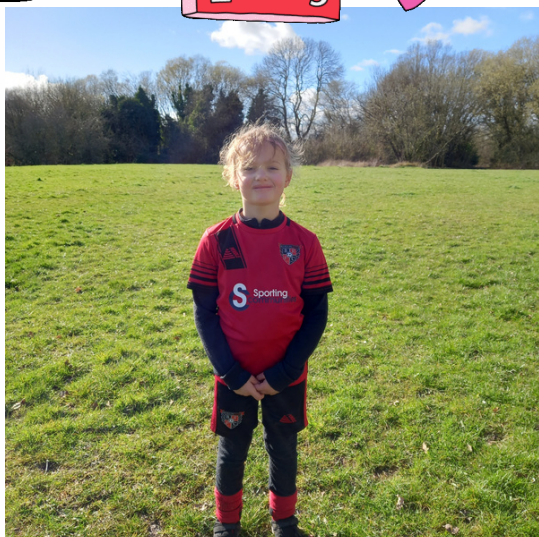
