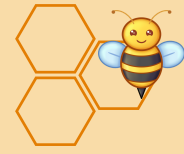

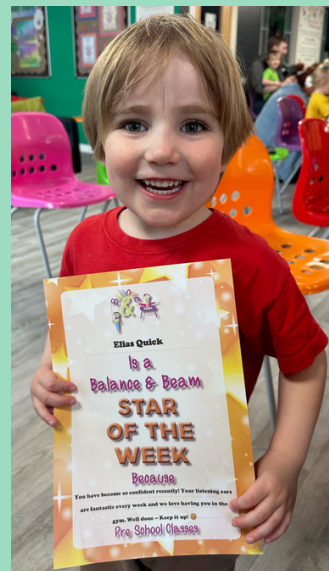
Elias Q - Nursery
