Have a lovely weekend - we hope to see more of our parents as we finish the summer term.

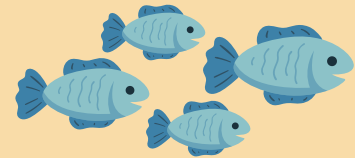

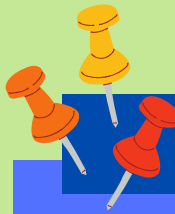
