Core Knowledge

Shops in Newcastle have changed from when my grandparents and parents were born.

In the past shops were small and only sold one type of item e.g a greengrocers, florist, butchers.

Today shops are bigger and you can buy most things from a supermarket.

Today shops look different from shops in the past.

The way you pay for items in a shop has changed over time.

Parents and grandparents can tell us about shops in the past.

Vocabulary

Today – Now, the present period of history.

Present - Things and people that exist now.

Past - The time before the present.

Change - When something or someone different.

Timeline - a way to organise events in the order they appear in history.

Approx 1960 - 1980 (the past when grandparents were born.)

Approx 1980 -2000 (the past when parents were born)

I was born 2017/2018

Today 2023 (the present)

Prior Knowledge

I know there was a time before I was born.
I know that some things were different when my parents and grandparents were born.
I know the past happened before I was born.
I know the present is now.

Prior Skills

I can use some chronological language including yesterday, last week, today, tomorrow when discussing my news.
I can look at pictures from the past and ask a question.
