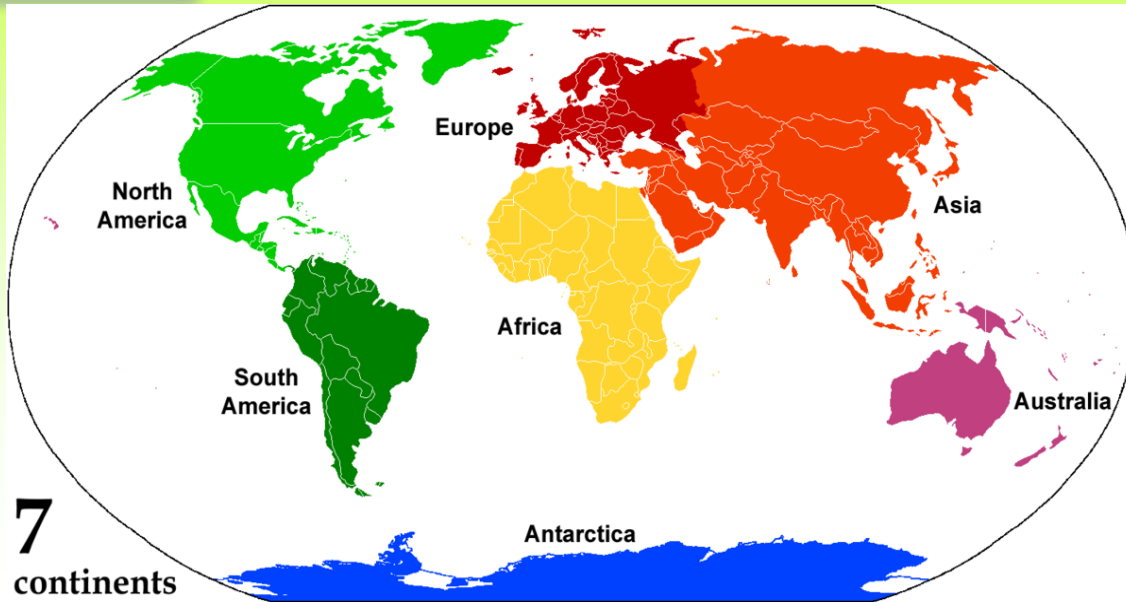


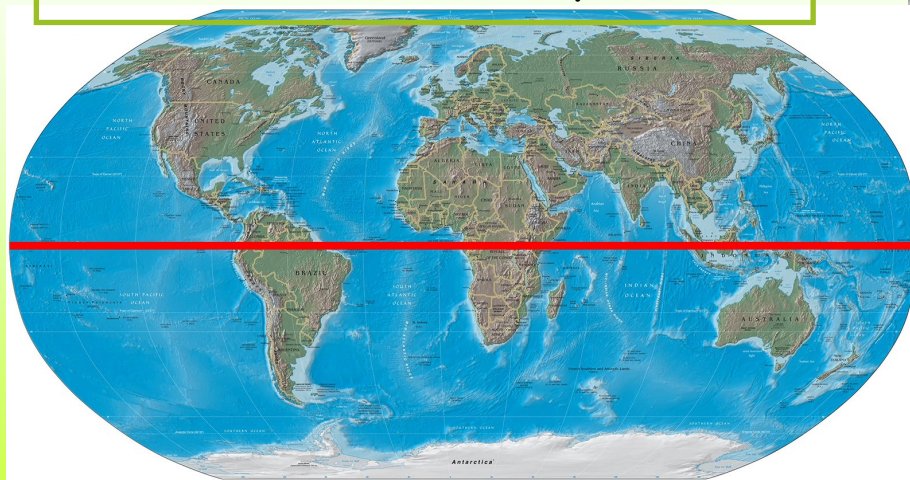
Y1 Summer Geography: What is a continent, how many are there and where can they be found?
